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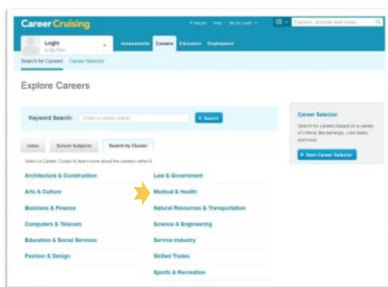

**Program Description**  
Established in 2005, the York-Seneca Rehabilitation Services Certificate Program is the only program of its kind in Canada. This program is offered jointly by York University and Seneca College of Applied Arts and Technology. It prepares undergraduate students to work in a wide range of rehabilitation fields by integrating academic training in health sciences and practical experiences. Graduates receive a B.A., B.Sc., degree or Honours B.A./B.Sc. degree from York University and a York-Seneca Certificate in Rehabilitation Services.

**What is Rehabilitation?**  
• enables persons with disabilities (physical, emotional or developmental) to reach an optimal level of functioning.
